
From the Office of the Prez





FOOD GLORIOUS FOOD

American Chop Suey - Sunshine Style

Ingredients:

2 lbs hamburger

1 med onion - chopped

1 lb bacon

1 large jar spaghetti sauce

Garlic

Italian spices

2 lbs elbows or other pasta choice like ziti

1 large can stewed tomatoes

Cook bacon in skillet. Put on paper towels to cool.

Without draining grease, add chopped onion and garlic (1 Tablespoon if chopped) otherwise cut up clove.

After onions and garlic are browned, add hamburger and Italian spices and brown off hamburger.

While hamburger is cooking - cook up the 2 lbs of pasta.

Drain pasta and put back in pan, add spaghetti sauce, chopped up bacon, stewed tomatoes and hamburger.

Stir and serve with garlic bread.
