## The State of the Flock

### PARROT HEADS HAVE SURPASSED THE 60 MILLION DOLLAR MARK FOR CHARITY!

2021 was yet another difficult year for many clubs, so much so that eight clubs ended up dissolving. However, with that said, our membership did increase slightly to just over 20,000. We currently have 195 active clubs.

Many clubs were able to return to their “Party with a Purpose” mission. As Bob Noonan announced, “Parrot Heads worldwide raised just under \$170,000 for the Alzheimer’s Association.” That is almost 170% over our goal! The Alzheimer’s Association was not the only charity that benefited from the hard work and generosity of the Parrot Head Nation. In addition to the \$168,908 raised for the Alzheimer’s Association, \$1,876,776 was raised for all the other charities combined. Yes, that is over 1.8 MILLION dollars! Parrot Heads not only raised money but volunteered their time combining for a total of 112,078 volunteer hours!

That brings the 20 year cumulative total to 60.25 MILLION DOLLARS raised for charity and 4.62 million hours of volunteer service! CONGRATULATIONS TO THE PARROT HEAD NATION FOR SUPRASSING 60 MILLION DOLLARS FOR CHARITY!

Each of you should be proud of the positive impact you’ve made in your communities, not just over the past year, for many of you have been contributing what may be considered a “lifetime” of service which has now resulted in over sixty million dollars being distributed to your local and national charities.

Although we did see a higher than expected number of clubs dissolve over the past year, we have received several requests for information to start new clubs in new areas. This gives me hope that we’ve turned the corner and will see a healthy increase in 2022!

## MOTM 2022, the Countdown is ON!



The countdown to the Meeting of the Minds is on, and there is no shortage of mile markers and celebrations at the 30th Annual Meeting of the Minds, brought to you once again by our friends at Margaritaville Island Reserve. In addition to its being the 30th gathering of the Parrot Heads in Paradise, we also continue the celebration of Mr. Buffett's 75th Birthday Year as well as the 200th Anniversary of the planting of the Stars and Stripes on the Island of Key West!

As many of you have heard, the Casa Marina Resort, which has hosted MOTM for 25 years, delayed a major renovation in order to allow the show to go on this year. While that means we will have one of the great musical parties in the history of the world this year, it also means that the Casa will be unavailable next year, and in all likelihood this will be the final MOTM hosted by Casa Marina. The Parrot Heads in Paradise Board has tasked a committee with determining whether another site and host in Key West is feasible, and with investigating and recommending potential host cities for MOTM 2023 and beyond, and that means that MOTM 2022 may be a swan song in the 25 year love affair between Parrot Heads and Cayo Hueso.

And if that's the case, Parrot Heads will be going out with a bang, not a whimper!

While there are more major artist announcements still in the works, the headliners and magic moments already on the schedule are worthy of a major anniversary celebration. Announced headliners include the fast rising beach country pop star Niko Moon, who has Nashville a-buzz with music with a tropical country vibe and modern beats. His mega-hit "Good Time" spent almost half of 2021 on Billboard's pop charts and touched number one on the Country Chart. He has scored hits with friend Zac Brown and Rascal Flatts and worked as a writer and producer with reggae star Michael Franti. With influences that you'd expect from a guy

Headlining Thursday night at MOTM is Sister Hazel, the Gainesville-based band that formed in the 1990s when the members were college students. All these years later, the members are still the same, and they're still having fun, so it's no wonder the Margaritaville Blog ranks them with Mac McAnally and Michael Franti as "acts you must see live." While they've enjoyed big pop hits like "All for You," "Change Your Mind" and "Your Winter," trop rock fans take note that a cover of their song "Sail Away" was included on award winning trop rock duo Thom and Coley's album Shotgun.

Award-winning Reggae artist and Buffett pal Mishka will be among MOTM Saturday's headliners. With multiple chart topping reggae albums and hits, the Bermudan former windsurfing star has been among the genre's leading performers for a quarter century, including as a Mailboat Records recording artist and as a Buffett co-writer.

## Interim Reports Will be Due beginning JULY 1st, 2022!!

**Interim Reports** are due into the PHIP Membership Office beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> and late after July 31<sup>st</sup>.

After July 31<sup>st</sup>, there are consequences. The penalty for delinquent filing of the Interim Report shall be a fine of \$100, payable to the Lone Palm Foundation *Parrot Head Emergency Phund*.

The Interim Report is simply a brief free-form synopsis of your Club's charitable, civic and environmental activities for the period **01/01/22 - 06/30/22**. It should contain who, what, when & where and should provide a contact name, if appropriate.

Also required is a current officer list with names, position, email address, home address and phone number.

ALL Chapters must file an Interim Report ... If there is nothing to report, please so state.

Beginning on July 1<sup>st</sup>, please email your Interim Report and current officer list

to [phipmembership@gmail.com](mailto:phipmembership@gmail.com) with Interim Report in the subject line. An email will be sent to confirm receipt of your report.

I would also like to suggest you CC your Regional Communicators, and then they can take you off their "reminder/pester" list!!!

FOR ALL YOU NEW CLUBS and/or NEW LEADER'S, your Regional Communicators will be happy to answer any questions about this REQUIRED reporting to PHIP.

## PHiP Scholarship Contest Now Open

We are proud to announce that the PHiP Bob Heffelfinger Memorial Scholarship Essay Contest for 2022 is NOW OPEN!!!!!!

### Summary of the PHiP Scholarship:

The PHiP Scholarship is for current Parrot Head Club Members of an officially Chartered Chapter or the children of Parrot Head Club Members, for post secondary education.

This program was established in 2008. Three scholarships will be awarded in 2022. The funds may be used for tuition, books or living expenses, at an accredited brick and mortar four-year university or college of the student's choice. The award will be paid to the winners school account, when a student account is established.

PHiP awards 3 awards in the amounts of:

**First Place: \$5,000**

**Second Place: \$3,000**

**Third Place: \$2,000**

Eligibility: Parrot Head Club Members and members children (Sorry nieces, nephews or other extended family members beyond those mentioned are not considered eligible).

It is VERY important the applicant follows ALL of the rules and instructions. Only typed, electronic submissions will be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered eligible. Make no references to your identity, your local Parrot Head club or your location in your essay entry OR your question and statement responses. All applications must be signed at the appropriate place. We accept electronic signatures.

**DEADLINE FOR APPLICANTS is April 30th, 2022, for enrollment for fall term (summer terms not applicable). Students may apply yearly; the awards will be given annually, based on a new application process.**

\* Many clubs don't enter because they think it's based on membership or fundraising numbers.

**NOT TRUE!!**

**Here are a few hints that might help:**

1. **BE CREATIVE!!** (if it looks boring & not fun to read and it really has nothing but fundraising figures, it's probably going to get a low score). Make it fun to read! We know you all are creative out there! You show your creativity in your concert attire, tailgating, event decorations and events! Put that same creativity to paper!!

**2. Read last year's winning essay, as well as previous winning essays!!** They are posted at: <http://www.phip.com/club-winners>.

Use their creativity as a Guideline!

**3. You can't win if you don't enter!!** The Golden Coconut Award is like winning the Lottery of PHIP and puts your club membership into a very unique and small group of Clubs who use their win to their advantage! You have bragging rights to use on your website or on your club merchandise! You know you love to talk about your club to anyone who will listen!! Imagine telling a potential sponsor of your event or club that *your* club is a Golden Coconut Winner and then explaining what it stands for!! **We know you can be loud & proud.. put that spirit down on paper!!**

**4. Follow the rules!!** Yes, we gotta have some stinkin' rules ... (as all contests do, see sidebar to right).

**5. Don't have time to write a blind essay to submit???** I would be willing to bet that you have someone in your club who is a creative writer! Tap them as a resource!! There is NO rule that the Golden Coconut must be written by a Club's Officer; the GC just needs to be submitted by the club's contact!! Sometimes a member who would love to contribute in some way just needs to be asked!

**6. Every chapter, with the exception of previous Golden Coconut recipients [from 2017 to 2021](#), regardless of size or age, has an equal opportunity to win this most coveted designation!**

## Alzheimer's Walk 2022!!!!!! Let make this an unforgettable event

The Walk Season for the fight against Alzheimer's is beginning. It easy to sign up and get your team and team members registered.

Here is how you make it happen:

- Find your local Walk to get started. Visit [alz.org/parrotheads](http://alz.org/parrotheads). Click Start or Join a Team.
- Look for your local Walk by State or Zip.
- Allow your device to access your location.
- Use the interactive map.
- On your local Walk page, click "Register."
- Sign In.



Nationally, we have 30 Teams/Clubs registered and have raised \$9,897.00 of the PHIP goal of \$100,000.00. It seems like a big amount but not for Parrotheads!!!! Last year we went well over our goal. This year I lost a friend who had early onset Alzheimer's and passed away at the young age of 62. This is a terrible disease, and we need to find a cure. In 2020, Covid-19 contributed to a 17% increase in Alzheimer's and dementia deaths. The government has increased its funding, but it's not enough.
