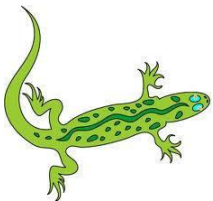

Recipe of the Month: Submitted by Sunshine

Caribbean Coconut Chicken Servings

Serving Per Recipe: 4

4 skinless, boneless chicken breasts
1 teaspoon vegetable oil
1 ½ onions, chopped
1 red bell pepper, chopped
1 green bell pepper, chopped
1 tablespoon chopped roasted garlic
½ (14 ounce) can coconut milk
Salt and Pepper to taste
1 pinch crushed red pepper flakes

Directions

- Preheat oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C).
- In a large skillet, fry chicken breast in vegetable oil until the chicken just begins to brown.
- Stir onions, green bell peppers and red bell peppers into the skillet with the chicken. Saute until the onions are translucent.
- When the vegetables are translucent, stir in the garlic and coconut milk.
- Let the mixture cook 5 to 8 minutes before removing the skillet from the heat.
- Season with salt, pepper, and red pepper flakes.

- Transfer the mixture to a 9x13 inch baking dish and bake in a 425 degrees F (220 degrees C) oven for 45 minutes, or until the vegetables cook down and the chicken is tender.
